### Summary of the year:

21 Anglers recorded 1531 fish of 30 species including 2 Specimens during the 2018 season.

The humble L.S. Dogfish was again the most prolific with 855 caught, the ban on retaining Bass until October had an impact as they weren't officially targeted, there was a noticeable increase in the numbers of Thornback Rays (41 from 24) whilst the numbers of Undulates (53 from 40) caught remained about the same, the numbers and size of Bream dropped significantly (163 from 304).

We only managed to fish 3 of the 11 planned dinghy competitions and the Away Trip to Penzance due to severe weather, with one Charter trip to the mid channel wrecks resulting in 125 miles travelled, 8 wrecks visited and only 2 fish caught.
